"Once the award is held for ten consecutive years, you enter the NFDA Hall of Excellence," he says. "And that is definitely our qoal!"









The Office of the Chief Medical Examiner (OCME) has developed a statewide Mass Fatality Response Team (MFRT) in coordination with the Virginia Department of Health's Office of Emergency Preparedness and the Medical Reserve Corps (MRC).

MRC units are teams of medical and public health professionals who, along with interested community members, volunteer their skills, expertise and time to support ongoing public health initiatives and assist during emergencies throughout Virginia. MRFT members are trained by their MRC units and the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner (OCME) to work under the direction of the OCME in scene/morgue operations, family assistance center operations, or both operational units.
